Construction is commencing on two important preservation projects in Red Cloud: restoration of the Willa Cather Childhood Home and rehabilitation of the Potter Block to become Hotel Garber. A bronze sculpture of our prized author will be unveiled in the U.S. Capitol as part of the National Statuary Hall Collection. We'll celebrate 150 years of Willa Cather (she's never looked better)! Last but not least, the Pulitzer Prize was bestowed on Cather nearly one hundred years ago, and 2023 marks publication centenaries of her *A Lost Lady* and *April Twilights and Other Poems*.

To mark these important occasions, we will organize commemorative exhibits and host celebratory events in Red Cloud and beyond. You'll have ample opportunities to engage with Cather's writing and settings, through a combination of on site and virtual offerings. We'll display unfamiliar Cather artifacts from the collection, host an inaugural Willa Cather Residency for Artists, and support teachers and students as they bring Cather into the classroom. All of this will allow us to enrich more lives, and it will only be possible with your continued generosity. It's your support that enables us to expand our arts, education, and preservation efforts. This year and all years, we thank you.


To promote Willa Cather's legacy through education, preservation, and the arts.

# **Fulfilling Experiences: Educational Opportunities Abound**

"I like to tell people that I meet, in and outside Nebraska, that my summer in Red Cloud as a humanities intern at the National Willa Cather Center was one of the most fulfilling seasons in my life so far. To be able to have a professional, paid summer experience within the humanities so close to home is rare and unparalleled in rural Nebraska. Through this internship, I was able to explore various subfields of the humanities in one organization; network with scholars, patrons, artists, and trustees; and become a part of the lovely community of Red Cloud. Even as I travel throughout Europe pretending to be Cather and live in Greece as an educator, I find my soul visiting the prairie every once in a while."

Engaging students and lifelong learners has always been central to our mission, but this year our education efforts grew to create deeper connections with elementary school and university students. New activities for fourth grade field trips to the National Willa Cather Center included "Guess the Gadget," an opportunity to learn about items in our archival collections; and "Be a Letter Detective," which asks classmates to work collaboratively to decipher Cather's handwriting. A new collaboration with the University of Nebraska

Foundation, the Cather Project, and the Cather Archive offers a paid summer humanities internship. The program allows college students to create educational resources while learning about museum operations through tours, archival work, and events. These talented and inquisitive young people are an inspiration, and we're grateful to have opportunities to engage with them about Willa Cather, the arts, and the humanities.



Students from the University of Nebraska at Omaha traveled to Red Cloud with professor Todd Richardson to take guided tours and provide feedback about how we can enrich the visitor experience. Their suggestions will help inform the reinterpretation of our historic sites.

Deciphering Cather's script handwriting proved a difficult and amusing task for fifth grade students in Mrs. Faimon's Red Cloud Elementary School class.



# **Enlivened By Restored Beauty: Preservation Efforts Advanced**

"Beautiful windows are a treasure but, like all treasures, they must be cared for, especially when they are part of Cather's own personal legacy. When Nancy and I walked into Grace Church this past spring we were greeted by an amazing sight—that old, dim interior was sparkling with light and color due to the restoration of the windows, the enhanced lighting, the polished wood. What a wonderful difference it makes. Preservation efforts have been a constant focus since our founding, but we made immense strides this year with major restoration efforts that were a part of our capital improvement plan. In all, four historic sites with a direct connection to Cather's writing and life were given significant attention. The Burlington Depot and Pavelka Farmstead are now accessible and better protected from the elements with restored windows, doors, and new siding. The interiors of both sites were also restored to their respective periods of significance. An interior and exterior rehabilitation at the Farmers and Merchants Bank preserved this iconic site and prepared the space for new exhibits. A final undertaking involved restoration and protection of priceless stained glass windows at Grace Episcopal Church, two of which memorialize Cather's parents.

# Play and Experimentation: Art and Artists Championed

"The Foundation's support as we developed Henrietta Solway, a new work based on Cather's writings, was invaluable. Their financial support allowed us a freedom in the rehearsal room that is rarely possible for artists. We were able to play and experiment with new kinds of artistic choices, intertwining music more closely with the storytelling and working with an additional performer. The Foundation also brought Cather's magazine writings to our attention, opening up to us a whole new side of her work, and her biography."





The arts-based aspect of our mission touches both artists and patrons of the arts. In its first full year, the Author Series program expanded to include a wide range of authors with connections to Cather, Nebraska, and beyond; it made writers accessible to over six hundred readers nationwide. Visual artists who had their work shown in the art gallery were lauded by visitors to the National

Willa Cather Center, as well as thousands of virtual guests who browsed the accompanying online galleries. Commission of a new play inspired by Cather's short stories, serialized novels, and personal letters introduced new audiences to the author's work, and will continue to do so as part of the Lied Center's Arts Across Nebraska program when it tours in 2023.
